 - 4.2.1 Graduated from Bachelor of Nursing. The average grade (GPA) is not less than 2.50.
- 4.2.2 Have nursing professional practice experience in adult and elderly nursing of at least 1 year after graduated bachelor degree.
 - 4.2.3 Licensed as the practitioner in nursing class 1, approved by Nursing Council.
- 4.2.4 In case of an applicant who is not Thai, she/ or he is needed to be prepared with a bachelor's degree in nursing science or equal, and received nursing and midwifery license from her/ or his own country, if there is not, the applicant is needed to receive a certificate of registered nurse or certified by nursing regulatory authority from her/ or his own country
- 4.2.5 Meet the English language requirement, as determined by the graduate school: PSU-TEP score 3 average no less than 60% of the skills or knowledge or an equivalent examination result from another graduate school or Institute, not more than 2 years old at admission:

TOEFL (Paper Based) not less than 500 score or TOEFL (Computer Based) not less than 173 score or

TOEFL (Internet Based) not less than 61 score or

TOEFL (Institutional Testing Program) not less than 520

IELTS not less than 5.0 score or

CU-TEP not less than 60 score
