



## **Memorandum of Understanding**

### **BETWEEN**

**FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA**, an institution of higher learning, established under the laws of the Republic of Indonesia, having its address at Sawo Manila Street, Pejaten, Pasar Minggu District, Jakarta Selatan City, DKI Jakarta Province 12520, Indonesia.

### **AND**

**FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND** is one of the most renowned universities in Thailand, with the present postal address is No. 15 Karnjanavanich Road, Hat Yai, Songkhla 90110, Thailand.

### **WHEREAS**

The **FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA** and the **FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND** have agreed to develop links with each other and look forward to a long and successful collaborative relationship which is hoped will be of great benefit to all parties.

This MoU has been drawn up following preliminary discussions held between the **FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA** and the **FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**. This MoU is intended to record on a non-legally-binding basis, the terms upon which the Parties intent to collaborate in areas of mutual interest.

#### **1. PURPOSE OF MOU**

The Purpose of this MoU is to strengthen ties between the **FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA** and the **FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**, and to promote academic collaboration and understanding of cultures between Indonesia and Thailand.

#### **2. SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of the activities of the MoU shall include:



a) Indonesian and Thailand Students Exchange Programs

The FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA and the FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND will seek opportunities to hold Indonesian and Thailand student exchange programs which will include the provision of library access and academic assistance. Such exchanges shall be negotiated and agreed to by Parties on a case-by-case basis.

b) Academic Staff Program

Visits by academic staff from both Parties will be encouraged for the mutual benefit of the parties.

The host Party will assist in arranging accommodation, immigration, language, and local custom for the visiting scholar.

c) Collaborative Research

The FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA and the FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND will seek opportunities to cooperate in research. The universities will seek funding opportunities to cooperate in this area of research.

The details of further specific research areas will be determined by the mutual agreement of the Parties.

### **3. COSTS**

The FACULTY OF NURSING, UNIVERSITAS NASIONAL, INDONESIA and the FACULTY OF NURSING, PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND shall each bear its own costs and expenses in fulfilling this MoU.

### **4. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION, TERMINATION**

The MoU shall commence on the last date of signature hereof and shall continue for a period of three (3) years (2024-2026), unless terminated in advance by either Party. This MoU may be extended by written mutual consent of the Parties.

The MoU may be terminated by either Party by giving written notice at least three (3) months in advance to the other Party. The termination of this MoU will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host institutions.



The MoU is entered into English and Indonesian, each version shall be equally authentic and in the event of conflict or misinterpretation, the English version shall prevail. The MoU is made in two (2) copies, each having the validity of the original.
