2. Criteria only to study plan A, A 2

(This plan is a two-year program, consisting of coursework and a thesis with a minimum of 24 credits of coursework and 12 credits for the thesis.)

- Graduated from Bachelor of Nursing. The average grade (GPA) is not less than 2.50.
- Have nursing professional practice experience in adult and elderly nursing of at least one year after graduating with a bachelor's degree.
- Licensed as a practitioner in nursing class 1 approved by the Nursing Council.
- In case of an applicant who is not Thai, she/r he must hold a bachelor's degree in nursing science or equivalent and have a nursing and midwifery license from her/ his country. Otherwise, the applicant must have a certificate of registered nurse or be certified by the nursing regulatory authority in her/ his country.
- Meet the English language requirement as determined by the graduate school: PSU-TEP score three average and no less than 60% of the skills or knowledge or an equivalent examination result from another graduate school or institute, which is not over two years old at admission:

TOEFL (Paper Based) not less than 500 score or TOEFL (Computer Based) not less than 173 score or TOEFL (Internet Based) not less than 61 score or TOEFL (Institutional Testing Program) not less than 520 ELTS not less than 5.0 score or CU-TEP not less than 60 score

3. Other criteria besides 1-2 are at the discretion of the committee.
