

Doctor of Philosophy Program in Nursing Science (International Program)



The Faculty of Nursing at Prince of Songkla University aims to prepare doctoral graduates with the knowledge and ability to generate nursing knowledge or innovations that meet international standards, considering academic ethics and working with interprofessional health networks at local, national, and international levels. The program emphasizes developing the skills and abilities of doctoral graduates to become future nurse leaders. In addition, the Faculty of Nursing collaborates with many other universities abroad. This collaboration will provide opportunities for PhD candidates to spend approximately 3 – 6 months studying abroad. Furthermore, there are overseas nursing professors visiting and joining classes at the Faculty of Nursing and/or through online systems.

Qualification of applicants

Plan 1.1 applicants who have completed a Master's degree

- 1.1 Master's degree in Nursing Science or equivalent
- 1.2 Have at least 1 published research article/a letter of acceptance over the past 3 years
- 1.3 Require proficiency in English Only official test reports are accepted. Scores must be from within the last two years.
- 1.4 Earn current professional license
- 1.5 Have good work experience, responsibilities and good behavior without a history of unethical and immoral behavior
- 1.6 No underlying disease to hinder the study
- 1.7 Other matters based on the appointed PhD. Committee's consideration

Plan 2.1 applicants who have completed a Master's degree

1. Earn the requirements in item 1.1 - 1.7 – except item 1.2 by having at least 1 published research article (from research studies/thesis) / received a letter of acceptance over the past 5 years.

Plan 2.2 applicants who have completed a Bachelor's degree

1. Be a graduate in a bachelor's degree in nursing or equivalent, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 (out of 4.00).
2. Earn the requirements in item 1.3 - 1.7
